- Open Services Gateway Initiative launched in March 1999 – 15 companies
- First Member Meeting: London – May 1999
- Specification Releases:
 - R1 – May 2000 (JES Framework)
 - R2 – October 2001 (Gateway Management)
 - R3 – April 2003 (Automotive)
- OSGi World Congress:
 - Stockholm – 24-27 September 2002
 - Düsseldorf – 21-24 October 2003
 - Barcelona – 11-15 October 2004
